

A student's guide through the complexity of time and knowledge

The main objective of Istituto Cairoli is the creation of a school aware of the needs of the students, their families and of the surrounding area and, at the same time, respectful of the individuals' different learning paces and styles. The school offers extensive cultural background, favours the development of communication skills both in the mother tongue and in the foreign languages, encourages the choice of further education, helps the student pick the most suitable university course. The students' motivation and involvement together with the student-teacher cooperation, are considered crucial to acquire the means to cope with the fast changing age we live in and the most diverse fields of knowledge.

School success, though, cannot be fully achieved without the families' constant support, an element of paramount importance in the education process.

The following values guide the whole educational activity:

- Equality – each individual's skills, motivation and commitment are enhanced by means of tutorial work, remedial and backup measures, designed to improve each student's learning mode. During the first two-year course the student is constantly monitored, which may imply psychological and didactic help and in some cases he/she may be referred to another curriculum.

- Fairness- the classes are formed, the teachers assigned to the classes, the teachers' timetable agreed on, the tasks distributed according to criteria of objectivity and equity in all fairness, taking every body's needs into account

- Freedom in teaching - Freedom in teaching is viewed as an important cultural resource. It is optimized, in compliance with the national recommendations, by the school collegiate bodies' directions by which it is governed.
